OLD RAUMA AND THE LIGHT HOUSE ISLAND – example group program

Program

9:00 AM	Arrival in Rauma
	The day in Rauma begins with a guided walking tour in the charming Old Rauma, a UNESCO World Heritage site. During the tour, the group will hear about the unique history and present of the area, and if possible, visit the beautiful Church of the Holy Cross.
10:30 AM	After the guided walking tour, the group will have free time to explore the lovely little shops in Old Rauma and purchase high-quality souvenirs.
11:30 AM	The group departs for an archipelago cruise (private charter) to the Kylmäpihlaja Lighthouse Island, with a journey time of approximately 50 minutes each way. Kylmäpihlaja Lighthouse is located right at the open sea. Despite its rugged appearance, the island, covered in sea buckthorn, is full of life, especially during the bird nesting season.
12:20 PM	Upon arrival at Kylmäpihlaja, the group enjoys a delicious salmon soup lunch, followed by free time to enjoy the island's nature. The most daring can climb up the light house tower to admire the sea view from the observation deck. Note! No elevator, only stairs.
2:00 PM	Departure back to the mainland, arriving at around 2:50 PM.
3:00 PM	Enjoy afternoon coffee with a sweet pastry at Marina Vista, located right next to the harbor at Syväraumanlahti.
	After the afternoon coffee, the group departs for home around 3:30 PM or according to the group's schedule.
