Program

- 10:00 AM Arrival in Rauma.
- The day in Rauma begins with a guided walking tour of Old Rauma. During the tour, the group will explore the colorful houses and narrow streets of this UNESCO World Heritage site, as well as the area's art and many artists. The tour includes visits to two artists' galleries and/or studios or alternatively, the Rauma Art Museum.
- Total duration of the tour is 2 hours.
- 12:30 PM Enjoy a delicious three-course lunch at Restaurant Villa Tallbo. The restaurant is located in a charming wooden villa near the sea.
- 2:15 PM After lunch, visit the Lönnström Art Museum. In the atmospheric home museum of Teresia and Rafael Lönnström, the elegance of the representative home blends with the coziness created over long-term residence. The museum also displays the couple's extensive art collection. The museum visit is guided.
- 3:15 PM The day ends with afternoon coffee at Marina Vista, located at Syväraumanlahti. Marina Vista is right by the sea, within walking distance of the Lönnström Museum.
- The return trip can begin around 4:00 PM.
